

# **Developmental Disability Services of Jackson County – eitas**

## **Community Services Board Report**

**December 2018**

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### **KCATA**

We are still working on this project. There are still individuals who have not received their no cost pass from our original list. This is because of some logistical as well as informational issues. New persons for bus passes have also started, who have not completed the KCATA application to date.

### **DMH Co-Occurring**

This group continues to be active. The stakeholder resource and crisis protocol training that was planned for February is being moved to June as the state needed more time to prepare.

### **Targeted Case Management**

Currently we have 50 Support Coordinators. There are 4 SCs who have applied for Senior SC. We are not currently hiring more SCs until all existing caseloads are full. These are caseloads of staff hired within the last 6-9 months who are either training or finishing training. We continue to accept newly TCM eligible referrals from KCRO and county to county transfers, which will fill caseloads. Our TCM census is 1783.

### **Community Resource Coordination**

There are currently 87 persons that we are providing non-TCM case management or community resource services to. We have revised our agreement with DMH. We will continue to receive referrals from KCRO intake and eitas TCM transfers. We will no longer accept any non-Medicaid cases that are currently open at KCRO. Most open KCRO individuals wanted a case manager and we do not have the program capacity to serve large numbers. Those persons staying with KCRO will be enrolled in their information specialist program and will not receive case management.

### **Crisis Services**

We continue to offer internal brainstorming sessions for SCs with an individual in crisis.
