Transportation Service Report to the Board November 27th, 2018

DOT received 19 transportation requests during the period 9/19/18 through 11/27/18; 8 were completed and placed on DOT routes, 5 are still being worked on, 2 were placed on the waiting list and 4 that did not qualify for our services (not in county, in grade school, etc.)

The winter season seems to have come early this year. We have had three snow events causing two days of transportation to be canceled and many cold mornings already. The extension cords we have been using at night to keep the busses plugged in and warm are being relocated from lying on the ground to reels located above the vehicles. This will keep the cords off the ground and reduce the trip hazard as well as making it easier for the drivers to plug in their vehicles.

A tire balancer and tire mounting machine have ordered for the Maintenance Department and we hope to have them installed and working yet this year.
